March 19, 2021 will be opening day of Miner Football spring season. Due to COVID restrictions and health guidelines, GHS will be allowed 400 home spectators and 200 visitor spectators to <u>Varsity games</u>. Therefore, all student athletes (football players, cheerleaders, dancers and band members) will receive 4 home tickets (3/19 and 4/2) and football players and cheerleaders will receive 3 tickets for each away game. <u>These tickets will be distributed 1 time only.</u> No one will be admitted into a home or away game without a ticket. If the student-athlete has extra ticket(s) that he/she cannot use, please send the extra(s) back to the office. There will be GHS students who will want and use a ticket to attend games and support the team.

When attending games, all spectators will be required to wear face masks and socially distance (in bleachers and in standing area). Gillespie fans will park in the North parking lot (on Broadway) across from the front of the high school or in the East parking lot (behind the DQ). Gillespie fans will enter through the East gate. Upon entry, fans will get their temperature taken and show their ticket.

Visiting fans will be asked to park at Bengil Elementary and enter the facility through the West gate. Porta potties and a concession stand will be provided for the visiting fans on the West side of the track/field.

Concession stands with pre-packaged snacks and drinks will be available for all attendees.

Home fans are asked to bring bottled Gatorade at the March 19 game, which is slated as Homecoming, while April 2 will be Senior Night.
